The MBIT Virtual Club collaborated with IMS Institute organized a three day Online Live Workshop on Aptitude for all students of all branches of the college on 15th and 16th April 2020 and followed by a mock aptitude test on 18th April 2020. Around 75 students attended the workshop.

On day 1, the speaker covered the topics on how to tackle Aptitude Test .The speaker covered different variations of questions in a particular topic that are frequently asked.

On day 2, the speaker covered the topics on how to tackle English and GD-PI (Group Discussion and Personal Interview)

On day 3, Mock Aptitude Test was conducted.

This Test contained total 45 Questions in 3 sections as follow:

1. Verbal Ability - 10 Questions
2. Logical Reasoning - 15 Questions
3. Quantitative Ability - 15 Questions

The students were benefited by the approach and shortcuts used by the speaker to solve a problem and also got their doubts cleared regarding a particular topic. The workshop received an overall positive response from the attendees and was termed as helpful in their campus placement preparations.

## **KEY POINT TO REMEMBER FROM THE SESSION:**

### **➤ Guidance to solve aptitude test:**

The essential to conduct aptitude test in companies were explained. Various sub-parts like Logical Reasoning and Verbal Ability were briefly interpreted. Few Questions were asked by the speaker. The session was made quite interactive by the speaker by conducting active polls and asking input from students in chat conversation. The students were given information about frequently asked questions in aptitude test conducted by different entrance exams like CAT/GATE/GRE, etc .The speaker taught some shortcuts/tricks for some complex calculations.

### **➤ Discussion to improve English language and build credibility:**

Data Interpretation , Listening and Reading section was explained in detail. The speaker gave accurate solution to overcome fear while communicating, to increase vocabulary and to speak fluently. The panelists suggested various books, editorials and websites that can help us improve English language and vocabulary.

➤ **Regarding Group Discussion and Personal Interview:**

GD-PI is an integral part of a recruitment process. To take this into account all the important points were put forth in a presentation format making it clear to the students. The speaker asked the students to write down the essential information. Various Myths, Do's and Don'ts were listed and explained in brief. Types of GD, skills which will be tested in GD, Areas of Interview and various commonly asked interview questions were discussed.

➤ **Mock Aptitude Test:**

The mock aptitude test gave students idea of what type of questions can be asked and how to solve it efficiently and properly in given limited time.
